Tasting Notes: Very expressive aromas on this wine with notes of bramble fruit, lavender, cherry blossom, pine, redwood, and creamy strawberry. The palate shows cranberry flavors, with bright acidity jumping upfront. There is a slight prickly texture on the mid-palate with fresh and light bodied notes throughout the mouthfeel.

"The 2020 Pinot Noir Peake Ranch Vineyard comes from the estate vineyard on the eastern side of the appellation and was destemmed and brought up in 32% new French oak. This medium-bodied effort has a seamless, focused mouthfeel as well as terrific aromatics that lead toward the red and black-fruited, iron, and spice-driven spectrum. I love its purity of fruit, it stays relatively tight and chiseled on the palate, and it has a great finish. It's going to drink nicely for 10-12+ years."
