Tasting Notes: This wine is a tribute to Daisy, our beloved winery dog (see her image on the cork!). Bellis Noir combines the brightness of Grenache with the brooding aspect of Syrah. The 2021 Bellis Noir opens with wild blackberry, licorice, and lavender on the nose. A lovely expression of angular tannins dominates the palate while notes of plum and peppercorn carry

through to the signature silky finish.

"The 2021 Bellis Noir checks in as 64% Syrah and 36% Grenache. Its ruby/purple hue is followed by a great nose of perfumed red and black cherries, licorice, peppery herbs, and leather. It's medium to full-bodied, has a seamless mouthfeel, and ripe tannins. Drink bottles over the coming 7-8 years or so." -Jeb Dunnuck
