Vibrant acidity and raspberry flavors are immediately present. Abundant refined tannins create a pleasant mouthfeel that is luxurious and contains elevated

fruit concentration.

"A darker, richer, slightly more serious wine, the Pommard-like 2021 Pinot Noir from Peake Ranch Vineyard offers a great nose of red and black raspberries, flinty minerality, forest floor, and leather. These carry over to the palate, where the wine is medium to full-bodied and has good concentration, plenty of tannins, and outstanding length. It will be even better in a year or two."
