Tasting Notes: This wine has an enticing bright red, burgundy hue. Aromas of strawberry, red plum, and dried currants are combined with anise and clove. Medium acidity and expressive bright red fruit flavors up front. On the mid-palate, tannin and acid combine beautifully, leading to a finish with a subtle

flavor of lavender.
