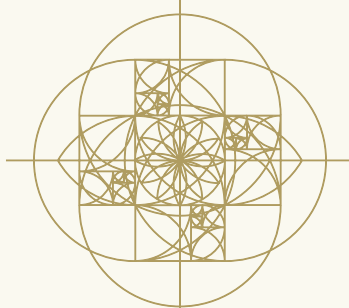
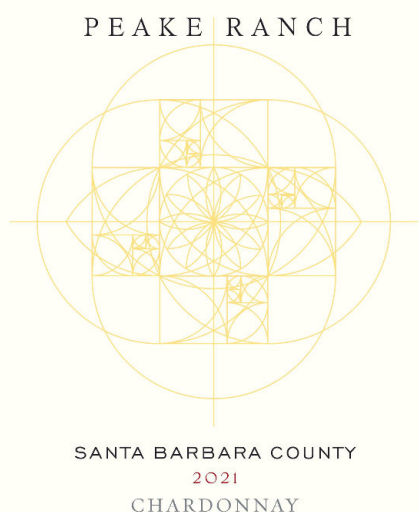

This bright and expressive wine exudes fresh notes of lemon zest, brioche, and citrus blossoms. There is a pleasant balance of acidity and texture along with a long finish. As it lingers, a delicate cinnamon and apple combo will start to surface.
