


## **2022 JOHN SEBASTIANO VINEYARD CHARDONNAY**

**Tasting Notes:** The 2022 John Sebastiano Vineyard Chardonnay is soft, yet vibrant. Lifted aromatics of white peach, honeydew, and graham crackers are

complimented by subtle vanilla and lime

undertones. The delicate inclusion of oak gives the

wine a gentle and lasting finish.

## 95 points Jeb Dunnuck:

"Last of the Chardonnays, the 2022 Chardonnay John Sebastiano Vineyard comes from a great vineyard on the eastern side of the appellation and was brought up in 28% new French oak. Ripe melon, salted citrus, crushed stone, and white flowers all define the aromatics, and this beauty hits the palate with medium to full-bodied richness, a pure, focused, chiseled mouthfeel, integrated acidity, and a great finish.
