Tasting Notes: Beautiful as ever, the 2022 Sta. Rita Hills Pinot noir is a gorgeous garnet color with wonderfully potent aromas of stewed strawberries, red plum, sage, and warm baking spices. Lush, fruity flavors and a hint of black tea leave the palate

yearning for another sip.

Fresh aromas of black raspberry, star anise and earthy tree bark show on the nose of this bottling. The palate snaps with a zippy acidity that floats flavors of dark berry, lavender and potpourri, finishing with a kiss of vanilla.
